Our topic this half term is 'Let's Celebrate'

Communication and Language

We will be listening to others one to one and in small groups.

We will be understanding the use of objects.

We will begin to use 'and' and 'because' in more complex sentences.

We will be connecting and explaining ideas.

Literacy

We will be enjoying rhymes and rhythmic activities.

We will be showing awareness of rhyme and alliteration.

We will be listening and joining in with rhymes and stories.

We will continue to give meanings to our marks.

Mathematics

We will be learning to sing number rhymes. We will be reciting numbers in order to 10. We will be counting objects and actions. We will be using the language of quantities e.g. 'more' and 'a lot'.
