Eco-Schools Topic:

Energy

Aim:

To reduce energy usage in school

Action(s):

To monitor if lights and interactive whiteboards are switched off.

Green Team to monitor at the beginning of each half term.

Focus on energy during switch off fortnight. Poster reminders to be distributed. Eco team to lead assemblies.

How long will it take?

- 15 minutes at the beginning of each half term
- During switch off fortnight, ten minutes each day during lunch
- Share with staff in briefing

Litter

Aim:

To ensure the school ground is tidy and litter free

Action(s):

Assign some Eco Team members as litter monitors

Litter monitors to do litter picking once a week in the playground.

Litter policy to be displayed in the playground.

Litter picking in our local community

How long will it take?

Once a week litter picking at lunch

Half termly litter picking in the local community

Who is responsible?

Eco team members

How we will monitor progress:

Revisit during a Eco Team meeting and check playground for impact. Check bins are being emptied regularly.

Waste minimisation/recycling

Aim:

To promote recycling
To minimise waste and encourage reuse of materials

Action(s):

Ensure all rooms have recycling bins
Assembly on what can be recycled
Bins to have posters and signs to show they are for recycling and what can be placed in them.

Monitor use of recycling bin and check if correct items are placed in them.

Pen recycling stations on corridors
Clearly signpost staff recycling areas

How long will it take?

Monitor bins half termly
Visit classes every fortnight and give top tips on how to recycle/reuse.

Who is responsible?

Eco Team and SB

How we will monitor progress:

Eco team to check each class and other shared spaces and feedback findings in meetings. Eco team lead to share with other adults in briefing.

Action(s):

Coffee morning on healthy packed lunches
Assembly on healthy food choices
