Dear Parents & Carers,

You will receive your child's termly report at our parents evening on the Thursday 28th November. A letter inviting you to parents evening along with details of the online booking system will have been sent home to you, if you haven't seen it, please check in book bags. We are keen to make sure that all parents meet with teachers and discuss their child's progress as well as take up the opportunity to look through their workbooks and celebrate their hard work, so if you haven't seen the letter, or are finding it difficult to make an appointment please call the school office so that we can help.

Reception places are allocated in a cross London scheme which is organised by our local authority, Hackney Learning Trust, not the school. If you have a child who was born between 1st September 2015 to 31st August 2016 then you will need to make an application for a Reception place regardless of whether your child attends our Nursery or has a sibling already in the school. Our Reception classes are very popular so don't miss the deadline for these applications which is **Tuesday 15th January 2020**. 
COFFEE MORNINGS
