LI: To write a character description

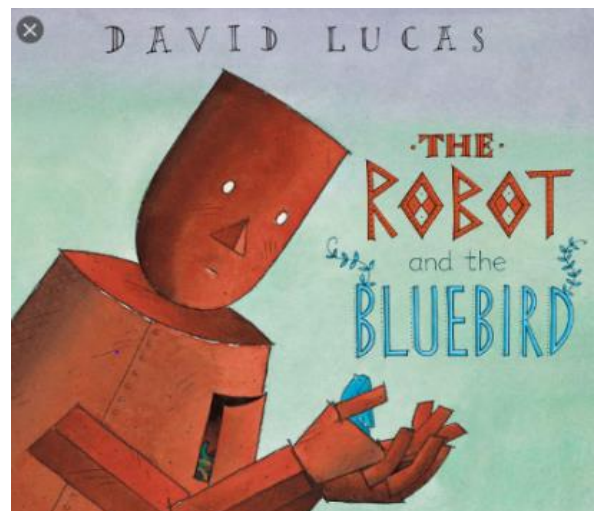
Success criteria:
