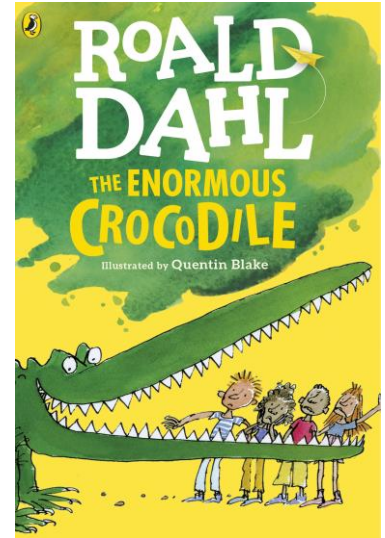

3. What does the word *flocked* mean?

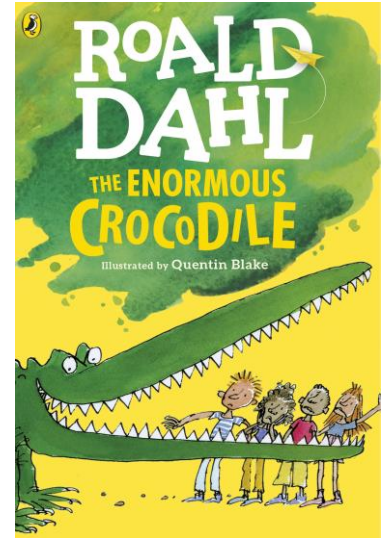
4. Find and copy the word from the text that means to eat quickly.

3. What was the name of the pretty little field? Can you describe it?

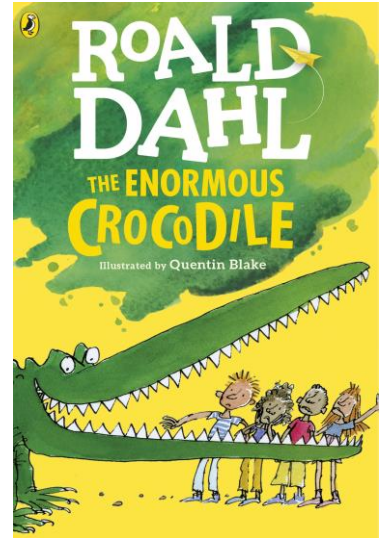

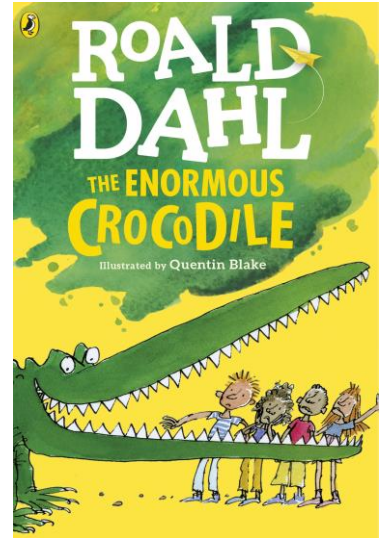
3. What are the boys and girls carrying?

3. Can you identify the **onomatopoeic** words on page 38? These are words that sound like what they mean e.g. **bang** or **crash**.

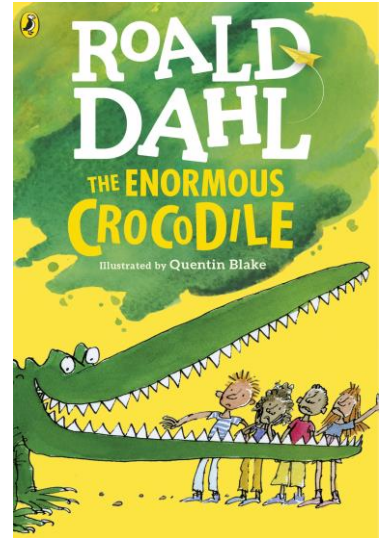
4. Which adjectives describe the voice from the jungle? Can you think of synonyms for these words?
