


EYFS Half Term Holiday Homework

Areas of Learning for Summer 2

Holiday homework project 'Capes and Crowns'

Who is your favourite superhero? Can you use the internet to find out about them? Why are they your favourite?

You could;

- Design and label a superhero costume
- Create your own costume from newspaper and sticky tape
- Create a superhero mask or wrist cuff
- Make a cape from an old t-shirt and decorate it

Understanding the World

- Can you experiment with the best materials to make a cape? Which is strongest / waterproof / lightest?
- Can you create your own superhero shadow just like Batman using scissors, paper and a torch?
- Can you design a 'super salad' of healthy foods to feed a superhero?

Maths- Shape, Space and Measure

- Can you experiment with the capacity of different containers? Which holds the most, least? Can you count how many spoonsful/cupsful each container holds?
- Can you create a super-assault course and time how long it takes to complete it?
- Can you use a toy with wheels to measure how far it goes? You could measure with your foot or by handprints. What happens if you add a ramp?

Art and Design

- Can you decorate a potato to look like Supertato?
- Can you act out your superhero comic book story?
- Can you use chalks, colouring pencils or paints to create a 'skyline' silhouette picture?
- Can you create a boat or plane for a superhero? How will it fly / float?

Literacy and Language

- Can you draw your own comic and write a sentence to describe what is happening in each picture?
- Can you write some sentences describing the superhero costume you have designed?
- Can you write about a real superhero you know? They could be a family member or friend. What makes them super special to you?
