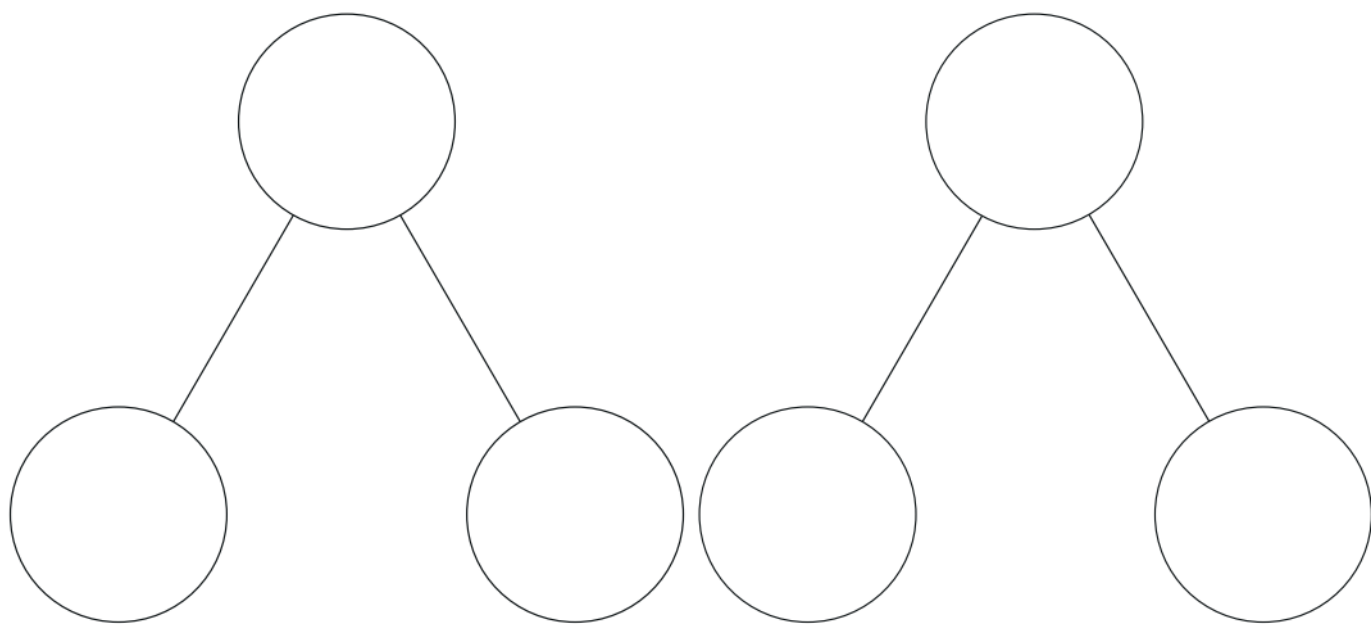
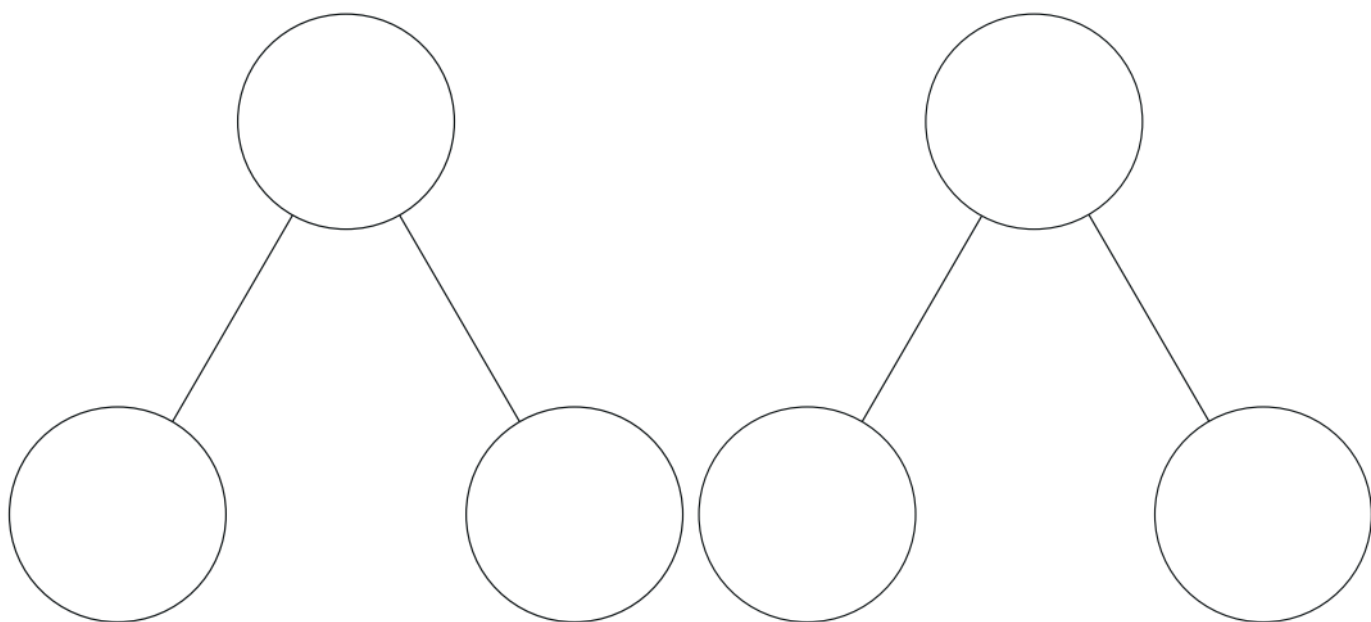
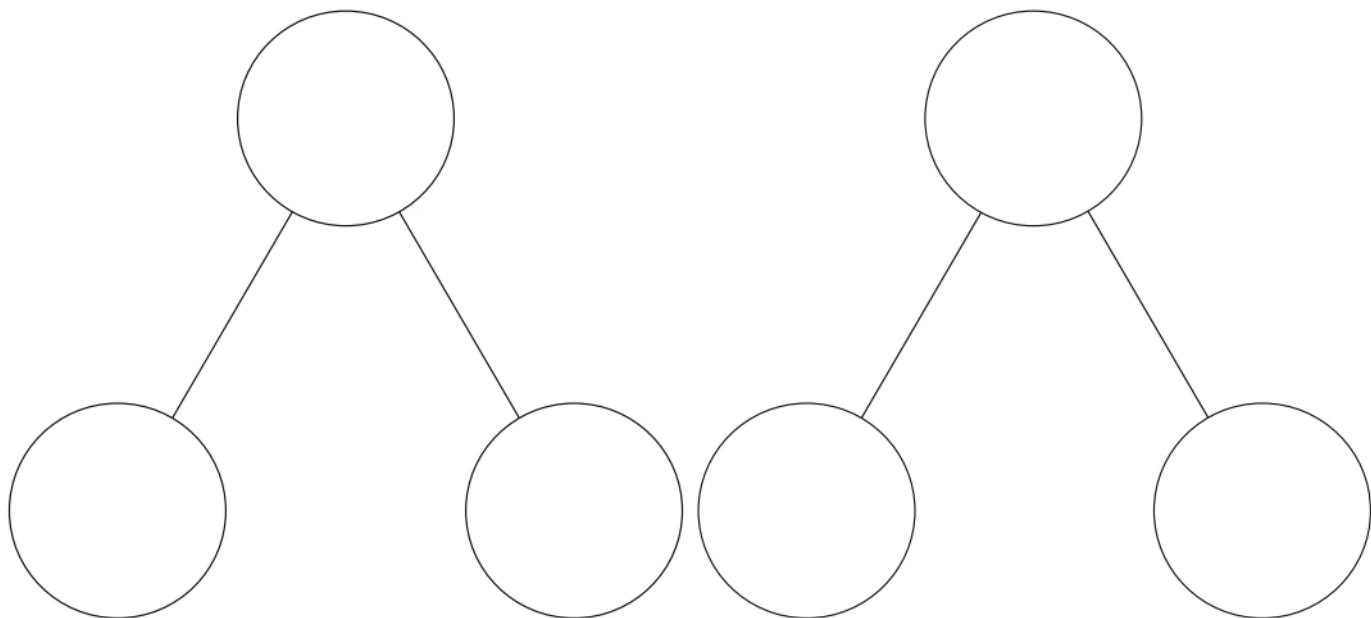
For this activity you will need:

- Small Objects for counting

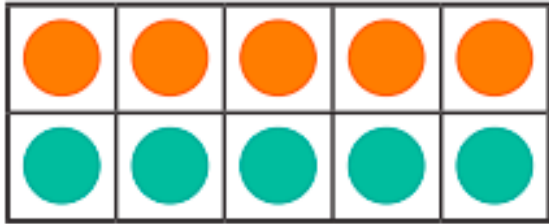
Task:

- Can you record your findings as marks or numbers? You can use the next page to record if you would like.

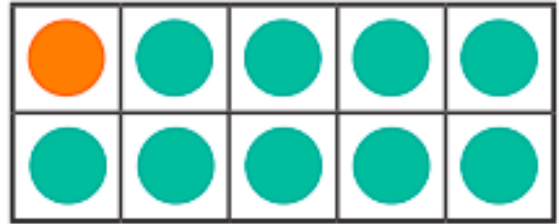




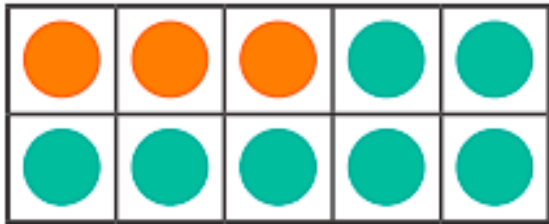
