


Topic Task Week 6 - Computing





Unit 2 HTML formatting and CSS

Step1: Use the link below to get to the correct webpage or type in 'Espresso Discovery' into google and it should be the top link.

Step2: In the top right of the screen there is a login tab. Click it and select coding. Then use the login details above to sign in.

Step3: You will see options like in the picture below. You need to click the middle option.





Step4: You will see options like in the picture below. You need to clock the HTML option.




Step5: Select Unit 2
