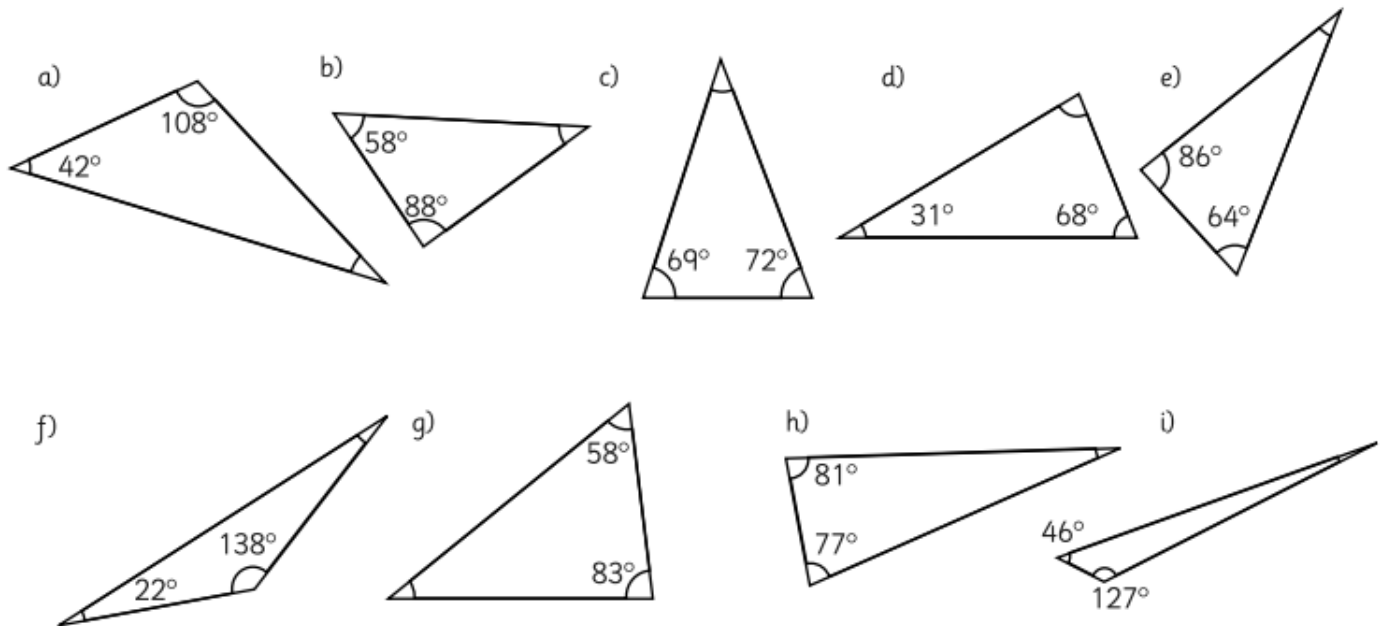

Is she correct? Explain why.

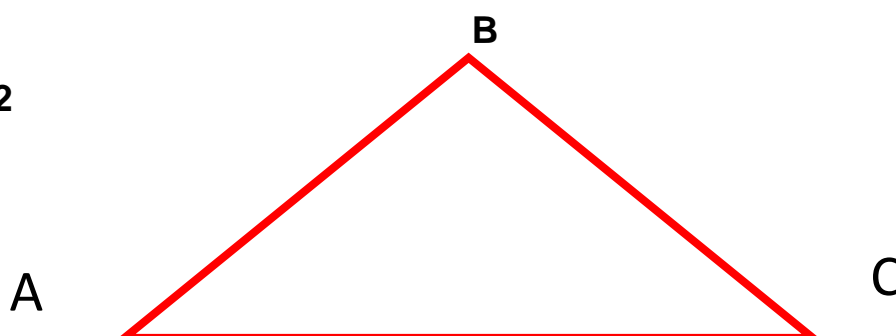
Problem Solving

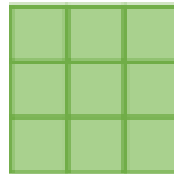

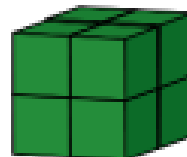
