e.g.

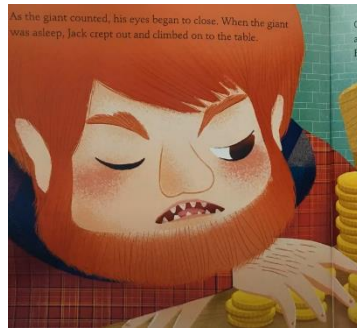
- The enormous terrifying giant






