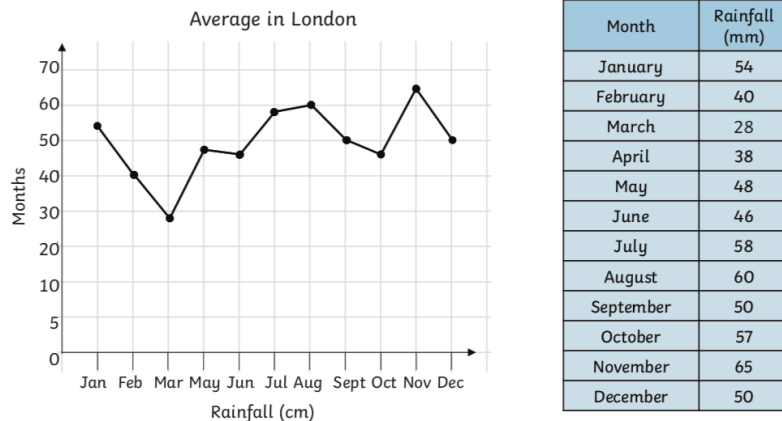

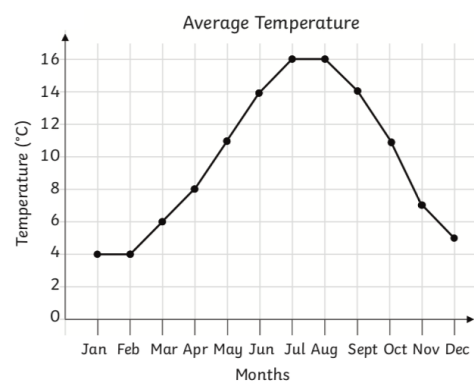
L1: To read and interpret line graphs

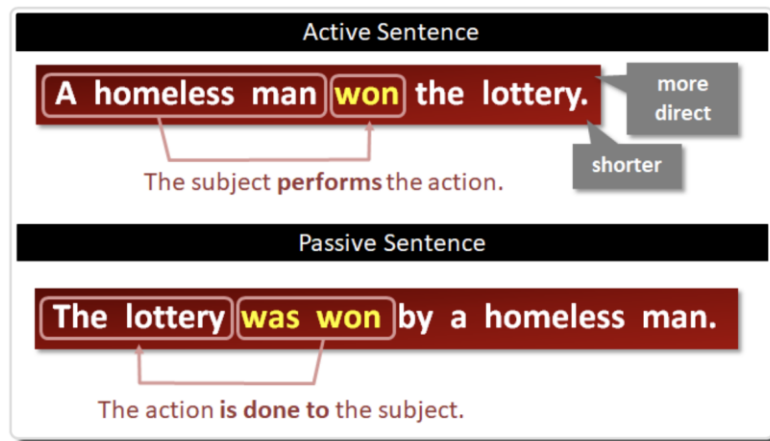
