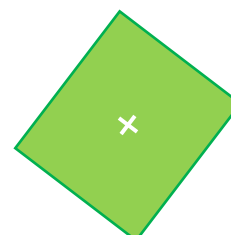
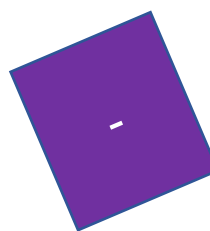
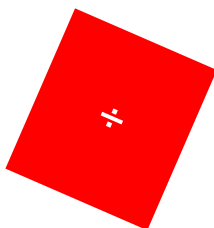
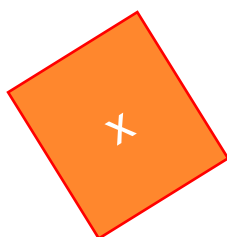
LI: to think systematically and problem solve with the four operations

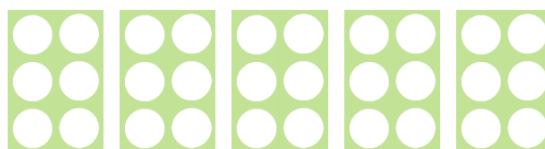
