Why is fairtrade important? How are people's lives made more difficult by not having a fair wage or price for the things they grow and produce? Watch the video:

After watching the video, complete the <u>'Home Recycling Survey'</u> with an adult in your house.

Here are some additional questions that you may want to think about and discuss them with your adult.

- 1) What items do you recycle at home? What about at school?
- 2) How do you know if an item can be recycled?
- 3) What are the benefits (positive effects) of recycling?
- 4) What are the negative consequences of not recycling?
- 5) What other ways can we reduce our waste at home or at school?

Think about the discussion points around recycling. You may wish to rewatch the video to help you remember some of the key points.

Create a poster all about recycling. You may want to include: why recycling is important, what items can go in the recycling and what the consequences might be if we don't recycle. Make sure to include drawings, labels and any extra important information, and don't forget a title!
