

Eco Learning Tasks

Watch the video 'A fair story' and then complete the activity grid with a parent or family member.

What is fairtrade? Why is it important? Where can you buy fairtrade products? How can we help to make the world a better place?

Watch the <u>video</u> about rubbish and recycling, then discuss the questons with your adult at home.

Why is important to put your rubbish in the right bins? What could happen if we don't? Why is it important to recycle? What happens to the items that we recycle? What items can be recycled? Take a look in your home recycling bin. What items do you see? What materials are these items made of?

Poster competition!

Think about the discussion points from the previous learning tasks around recycling. Create a poster about what items can go in the recycling or telling us why it is important to recycle. Draw pictures of the items and label them. Don't forget a title!
