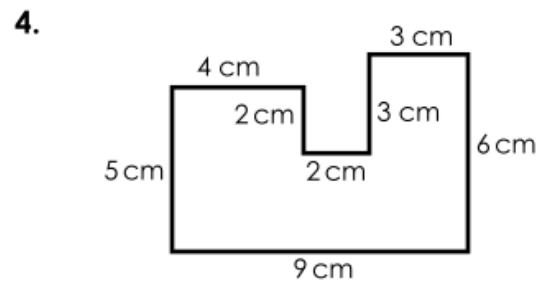
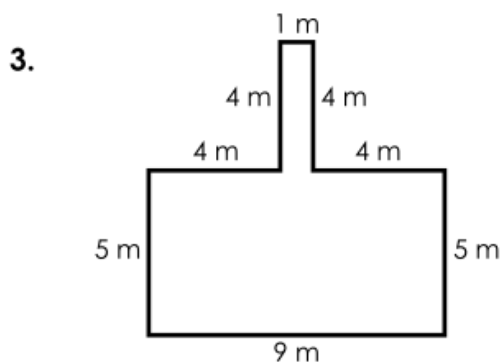

**Find the perimeter of these shapes**




**Now find the area of the same shapes**

**Area of an Irregular Shape**


To find the area of an irregular shape made of two or more rectangles, cut the shape into two or more parts and add the area of each part.



**Area of Rectangle 1:**  
 $A = l \times w$   
 $A = 4 \times 3$   
 $A = 12 \text{ m}^2$

**Area of Rectangle 2:**  
 $A = l \times w$   
 $A = 5 \times 3$   
 $A = 15 \text{ m}^2$

**Total Area:**  
 $A = 12 \text{ m}^2 + 15 \text{ m}^2$   
 $A = 27 \text{ m}^2$
