Action(s):

Promote walking during keeping healthy week

How long will it take?

- Walk to school day in May
- Travel survey in Spring
- Cycling session organised for each KS2 year group throughout the year.

Who is responsible?

- PE lead, PSHCE lead, Green team Lead, Green Team, Cycling Lead

How we will monitor progress:
Walk to school day will be evaluated through evaluations from parents and children.
Walk to school will be monitored online
Office will collect travel survey
Cycling lead to share timetable with Green Team lead.

Eco-Schools Topic:
Waste minimisation/recycling

Aim:
To promote recycling
To minimise waste and encourage reuse of materials

Action(s):

Ensure all rooms have recycling bins
On the recycling bins there are posters which shows what can be recycled and what can't be.

Assembly on what can be recycled
Monitor use of recycling bin and check if correct items are placed in them.

Pen recycling stations on corridors
Clearly signpost staff recycling areas

How long will it take?

Monitor bins half termly
Visit classes every half term and give top tips on how to recycle/reuse.

Eco Team and SB

How we will monitor progress:
Eco team to check each class and other shared spaces and feedback findings in meetings.

Eco team lead to remind other adults on recycling during briefing.
