2	<p><b>Rights Respecting Schools update</b></p> <p><b><u>What is current focus to gather evidence for your next stage of this quality mark?</u></b>  <b>Orchard:</b> In Spring Term we achieved the Rights Respecting School Award, we have now started to work on our Silver Award.  <b>Southwold:</b> We have achieved our Rights Respecting Bronze Award and are looking at how we can achieve the Silver Award next.  <b>Hoxton:</b> We would like to work towards our Rights Respecting Bronze Award.</p>	
3	<p><b>Updates on Key actions of School Council</b></p> <p><b><u>What have been the key actions of your School Council since we last met?</u></b>  <b>Orchard:</b> The School Council has been focused on raising money for our chosen charities. Recently we raised £131 for this. We have promoted these charities through assemblies and through our class council agenda.  <b>Southwold:</b> At Southwold, we have been focusing on healthy eating and having a school that is more Eco friendly. We have done this by ensuring the Green Team are more involved across the school by having weekly check-ins.  <b>Hoxton:</b> We have been focused on promoting positive behaviour towards each other.  <b><u>An example where you have supported adults onsite to adapt provision based on pupil voice feedback in weekly agendas?</u></b>  <b>Orchard:</b> At Orchard, we have used pupil voice to improve playground provision, by facilitating new football goals and identifying resources pupils would like. We also were able to adjust lunch calling so that Year 6 pupils don't always go last.  <b>Southwold:</b> At Southwold, we have had feedback from children across upper school to improve playground provisions, allowing boys and girls to have a fair opportunity throughout the week.  <b>Hoxton:</b> At Hoxton Garden, our peer mediators support in the playground and also to improve playground provision ensure there is a timetable for football in the MUGA. We are currently discussing ideas for the library.  <b><u>What have been your fundraising strategies for your selected charities?</u></b>  <b>Orchard:</b> During Summer Term, we have undertaken a bake sale. We also have an own clothes day and an ice lolly sale planned.  <b>Southwold:</b> Money raised at our Summer Fayre will be donated to charity. We have also undertaken a cake sale this term.  <b>Hoxton:</b> We have had a cake &amp; biscuit sale to raise money for our charity.  <b><u>What are the next steps for your School Council?</u></b>  <b>Orchard:</b> We are in the process of running auditions for Orchard's Got Talent in KS2. We are also reviewing key subjects like Science and Humanities to get pupil voice feedback.  <b>Southwold:</b> We would like to raise more money for our chosen charity. We would also like to promote Children's Rights across the school and we plan to do this by raising awareness using posters and reminding children of their rights. The School Councillors will be delivering an assembly to promote Children's Rights.  <b>Hoxton:</b> Our next steps are the Summer Fair and Hoxton's Got Talent.</p>	
4	<p><b>Display reflections from cross site meeting Spring Term</b></p> <p><b><u>What could each site do to further develop displays?</u></b>  <b>Southwold:</b> We have had a focus on pupil voice within inspiration stations. Next academic year, we plan to ensure that all classes will get a say about the theme and resources used within Inspiration Stations.  <b>Hoxton:</b> We would like to see other types of work being displayed around the school. We currently have art work and writer of the month.  <b>Orchard:</b> During Summer Term, we have had focus agendas around the importance of holiday homework, providing examples and having class discussions ahead of holidays. This meant there were a greater number of homework items brought in from Years 1-5. Year 6 continue to be a focus group.</p>
