Safer Internet Day	<p><b>Why do we take part in Safer Internet Day?</b>  <b>Holly:</b> To ensure that children are safe across the internet platform.  <b>Redwood:</b> To let children know that there are strangers who are not to be trusted.  <b>Hazel:</b> If we do not take part in Safer Internet Day, children will not know what to do if they come across something bad online.  <b>Maple:</b> Learn about apps and programs that are suitable for us.  <b>What did you find surprising or interesting about the activities you participated in?</b>  <b>Maple:</b> An activity we did was that we categorised apps and what you can do into ages.</p> <p><b>Redwood:</b> Assemblies covered what apps we are supposed to use, and many children were surprised.  <b>How do you make sure you are safe online (at school and home)?</b>  <b>Chestnut:</b> Only play with people you know.  <b>Hazel:</b> To have restrictions.  <b>Redwood:</b> Be careful about posting photos or videos of yourself or other children online that show private information.  <b>Cedar:</b> Do not send personal information to strangers.  <b>What new safer internet strategy will you be using from now on?</b>  <b>Chestnut:</b> Never trust people online as they could be faking it.  <b>What would you do if you felt unsafe accessing the internet?</b>  <b>Redwood:</b> I will block and report it.</p> <p><b>Maple:</b> I would tell an adult that could deal with the incident or if I am at school, I can tell one of the digital leaders.  <b>Hazel:</b> I would avoid the stranger or game online.</p>	Feedback to class teachers
